



PLAN AHEAD! ROTARY OFFERS SUMMER 2010 YOUTH EXCHANGE OPPORTUNITIES

Local students between the ages of 15 and 19 as of next summer will have the opportunity to participate in Rotary International's "Short Term" Youth Exchange Program, sponsored by the _____ Rotary Club. If accepted for participation, the local student would be paired with a student in the country of his or her choice, each to spend half the summer with the other in that student's home. Cost of participation includes an application fee of \$200, the student's cost of travel and spending money while abroad, and those costs associated with hosting the foreign student while here.

Families interested in participating may contact their local Rotary Club's Youth Exchange Officer for further information. Short Term Exchange application forms are available at www.rotary.org, and are to be typed and submitted to the applicant's local Rotary Club between December 1 and January 1 for submission to Rotary District 6420 Between January 1 and February 1. Participation depends upon Rotary's ability to arrange an appropriate match for each student. If a match is confirmed, the final schedule for the exchange is arranged between the reciprocating host families.
